

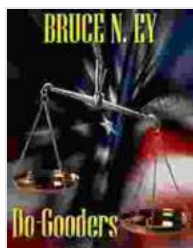
Do Gooders: The Inspiring Story of Bruce Ey

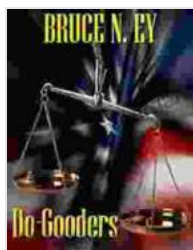
Making a Difference

help others, and that even small acts of kindness can have a big impact.

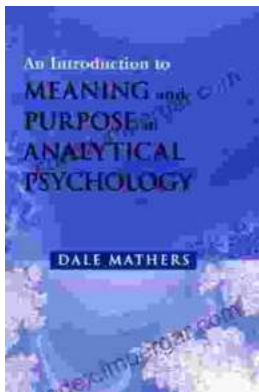
